Novel *Silas Marner* by George Eliot

Use the copy provided-Room 25.

Read the *Introduction* pages 193-196. As you read the novel, annotate (you may write in the book): notes in margin, highlight words (especially vernacular), note stylistic devices (such as similes, etc.).

For each chapter, do VOCABULARY FOR ENRICHMENT which begins on page 198. This will be turned in on the first day of school. Type the chapter then both the word chosen and the letter. Use the Gale group databases *Biography in Context* and *World History in Context* to do a one page report on the author and a one page report on the historical era. Use MLA format eighth edition. Correctly cite the sources (include both sources on the Works Cited page). Total of 3 typed pages.

These are due the first day of the school year-August 2017. You will be tested the second day of class: 20 multiple choice worth 100 points. Be prepared to discuss the author, the era, and the novel.
